Volunteer Opportunities

Female Volunteer Mentor:

Are you a good listener, caring, and have a concern for those facing an unplanned pregnancy? Become a volunteer mentor, and meet one on one with female clients to provide support and information to those faced with an unexpected pregnancy.

Volunteer Physicians:

Birthline's volunteer physicians confirm pregnancies and provide pregnancy verification forms allowing women the necessary means to apply for Medical Assistance and financial support. If you are a medical professional that would like to assist with this need, become one of Birthline's volunteer physicians.

Stepping Stones Store Volunteer:

Do you love to interact with parents and their children? Do you have a knack for organization and detail? In the Stepping Stones Store, clients spend "Decision Dollars" they have earned in Birthline's Stepping Stones Incentive Program. Volunteers are needed to sort through and price donations, and store clerks are needed to assist clients as they shop.

Male Mentor:

Have you fathered a child and would like to share your knowledge about fatherhood as well as provide good and accurate information about fathers' rights and responsibilities? Then become a male mentor to work one on one with male clients.

Birthline Doula:

Become one of Birthline's dedicated Doulas by providing comfort and support for women before, during and just after child birth.

HEART (Health Education And Relationship Training) Speaker:

Share the message of abstinence and how to create and maintain healthy relationships with the parents and youth in the community.
